Kairos presents mission as God's heartbeat - a thread that runs from Genesis to Revelation - and as you take time to explore this theme you are likely to find that God speaks into your life. Each study session allows time for personal reflection as well as an opportunity to talk through with others any new concepts or challenges that God may bring.

One of the exciting things about Kairos is that you see people grappling with God's purposes and beginning to apply that to the Church and the world around us. A regular feature of Kairos is prayer for the unreached peoples living around us here in the UK as well as overseas. We see people stirred up to action, thinking through how they can help make Jesus known both locally and globally. Through Kairos some have begun to engage with those of other cultures living around them; others become senders and pray-ers (the backbone of mission work); and some sense God's calling to work further afield.

Kairos is for anyone. It doesn't matter how long you've been a Christian. You don't have to be already committed to world mission. You might even already be a missionary! And if you're a pastor, this is something you and your church need to know about. Whoever you are and wherever you are at in your walk with God we believe Kairos has something to offer.
